## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE SALARIES FOR CASE COORDINATORS IN THE TWELFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT SHALL BE IN A UNIFORM RANGE BETWEEN THE COUNTIES OF THE CIRCUIT AND TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY RANGES AND EXPERIENCE LEVELS FOR CASE COORDINATORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The case coordinators serving the judges of the courts of the Twelfth Judicial District shall be entitled to receive a salary which shall be in a uniform range between the counties of the District. The salary range for a case coordinator in the Twelfth Judicial District with less than four (4) years of employment shall not be less than sixteen thousand dollars ( $\$ 16,000$ ), nor more than twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 27,500)$. The salary range for case coordinators with four (4) or more years of employment shall not be less than nineteen thousand five hundred (\$19,500), nor more than thirty thousand dollars $(\$ 30,000)$.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
hereby repealed.
