13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

15	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-1303 is amended to read as follows:		
16	"10-3-1303. Duties. The Joint Committee on Children and Youth shall		
17	7 make continuing studies and shall cooperate with the appropriate agencies of		
18	B this state, agencies of the United States Government, and the Congress of the		
19	9 United States in the exchange and dissemination of information and in the		
20	development of legislation designed to coordinate planning and to try new way		
21	to prevent young people from falling through the cracks."

23	SECTION 2. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are		
24	hereby repealed.

26	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature		
27	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code		
28	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to		
31	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect		
32	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without		
33	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this		
34	act are declared to be severable.
