## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE TWO OR MORE PEOPLE, REGARDLESS OF RELATIONSHIP, TO TAKE PROPERTY AS JOINT TENANTS WITH RIGHT OF SURVIVORSHIP; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS

SECTION 1. Interests in real property may be conveyed to two or more persons, regardless of their relationship to each other, as joint tenants with right of survivorship. Any person who owns an interest in real property may convey that interest or any portion thereof to himself and one or more other persons, regardless of their relationship to each other, as joint tenants with right of survivorship. Furthermore, all conveyances of real property made prior to the effective date of this Act and which clearly intended that the interests were conveyed as joint tenancy with right of survivorship even though the grantees were not husband and wife shall be deemed to have created joint tenancies with right of survivorship.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
