## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §5-64-101 BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION TO DEFINE THE TERM 'ANABOLIC STEROID'; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §5-64-101 is amended by adding the following new subsection:
" (x) The term 'Anabolic Steroid' means any drug or hormonal substance, chemically and pharmacologically related to Testosterone (other than estrogens, progestin, and corticosteroid) that promotes muscle growth. Except that such term does not include an Anabolic Steroid which is expressly intended for administration through implants to cattle or other nonhuman species and which has been approved by the Director of Health for such administration. If any person prescribes, dispenses, or distributes such steroid for human use, such person shall be considered to have prescribed, dispensed, or distributed an Anabolic Steroid within the meaning of this paragraph."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
