When a master street plan has been 1 8 19 adopted and filed as provided, the legislative body of the city, upon 20 recommendation of the commission, may enact ordinances establishing setback 21 lines on such streets and highways as are designated by the plan and may 22 prohibit the establishment of any new structure or other improvements within 23 the setback lines." 2.4 25 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 26 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 27 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 28 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 29 30 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 31 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
