Arkansas Code 10-3-701(b) and (c) are hereby amended to read 22 as follow: "(b) At the commencement of each regular session of the General 23 24 Assembly, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one (1) 25 member of the House of Representatives to fill each vacancy on the committee; 26 and the Committee on Committees of the Senate shall name, at the commencement 27 of each regular session of the General Assembly, seven (7) members of the 28 Senate to serve on the joint committee. 29 (c) The Senate Committee on Committees shall designate one (1) Senate 30 member of the committee to serve as Senate cochairman of the committee and one 31 (1) Senate member to serve as Senate vice chairman of the committee. The 32 highest ranking House member on the committee shall serve as House cochairman 33 of the committee and the second highest ranking House member of the committee 34 shall serve as House vice chairman of the committee." 35 36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 8 act are declared to be severable. SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 11 hereby repealed. APPROVED: 3-10-92
