SENATE BILL 43

**For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED §16-17-108(ccc)  
9 TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALARY OF A THIRD MUNICIPAL JUDGE IN  
10 THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS; AND FOR OTHER  
11 PURPOSES."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
14

15 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §16-17-108(ccc) is amended to read  
16 as follows:

17 "(ccc) The Little Rock Municipal Court Judges, First, Second, and Third  
18 Division, shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty-seven thousand  
19 dollars (\$67,000) nor more than seventy-seven thousand dollars (\$77,000)."  
20

21 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated §16-17-119 is amended to add a new  
22 subsection (c) as follows:

23 "(c) The governing body of any city or county having a municipal court  
24 as described in this section may by ordinance increase the number of municipal  
25 court divisions, each of which shall have jurisdiction coextensive with the  
26 county equal to the other municipal courts established within counties having  
27 a population of two hundred fifty thousand (250,000) or more inhabitants  
28 according to the most recent federal census, provided no city or county shall,  
29 under any circumstances, have a greater number of municipal courts than  
30 provided for in Ark. Code Ann. §16-17-108."  
31

32 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
35

36 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
