Exchange of districts. 17 (a) (1) Circuit judges and chancellors of their respective districts-18 19 circuits of this state and of their respective courts within the same numbered and geographically defined districts-circuits, whether denominated "Division" 21 or not, may by agreement temporarily exchange districts-circuits and may hold 22 courts for each other for such length of time as may seem practicable and for 23 the best interest of their respective districts-circuits and courts. The agreements shall be signed by the judges so agreeing and 2.4 25 entered on the record of the court or courts so to be held. It is the intent and purpose of this section: 26 To permit circuit judges to exchange districts-circuits with 2.7 28 each other: To permit chancellors to exchange districts-circuits with 29 (2) 30 each other; 31 (3) To permit circuit judges to exchange districts-circuits with 32 chancellors: and 33 To permit chancellors to exchange districts-circuits with 34 circuit judges. (c) As used herein the terms "district" and "circuit", singular and 35

36 plural, are synonymous and interchangeable, denoting the geographical area of

                     The provisions of this act are procedural in nature and
10 therefor shall apply to all cases presently pending or subsequently filed in
11 any circuit, chancery or probate court within the State of Arkansas.

         SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

14 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
15 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

18 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
19 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
20 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
21 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

         SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
26
27 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the opinion of the Arkansas Supreme
28 Court in the case of Tony A. Lee v. Andre McNeil, Chancellor and Probate Judge
29 et al., #CR 91-153, delivered January 27, 1992, cast substantial doubt on the
30 legality of the exchange of circuits between and among circuit judges and
31 chancellors within the same numbered and geographically defined districts-
32 circuits; and that the inability of respective judges so to exchange circuits
33 will seriously impair the timely and expeditions dispatch of the business of
34 such courts and will entail unnecessary and expensive delay in the termination
35 of cases in such courts. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
