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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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14	SECTION 1. For the purpose of this Act:
15	(1) "Center" means the Center for Workforce Excellence; and
16	(2) "Department" means the Department of Higher Education.
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18	SECTION 2. (a) There is created in the Department of Higher Education
19	the "Center for Workforce Excellence" which shall conduct a pilot project to
20	assist industrial development through the coordination of training programs
21	and services.
22	(b) The pilot project shall be a cooperative effort among the
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	Henderson State University, Ouachita Technical College, Arkadelphia High
25	School, Malvern High School, private industry, and other appropriate groups.
26	(c) Local industrial groups, local governmental units, and private
27	enterprise should provide much of the financial support needed for the pilot
28	project. Such support should include financial support for items such as
29	office space, expenses, and utilities.
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31	SECTION 3. (a) The goals of the Center shall be to:
32	(1) Facilitate the development of students and workers, members of
33	the "learning force" within Arkansas communities and companies, with a focus
34	on workers' skills and workplace tools of the future, particularly high level
35	technical training and education.
36	(2) Foster skills, knowledge and understanding relevant to real

world jobs, careers and lifestyles through the economic competitiveness of
 students, workers, communities, companies and associated groups in a global
 political community.

4 (b) The Center shall develop a strategic management plan to include 5 initial industry services training, with a survey of existing facilities, 6 opportunities for training with the potential project area, and development of 7 a campaign plan to overcome training deficiencies in the areas through 8 reliance on existing resources through the cooperation and development of new 9 training capability through innovative low cost means.

10 (c) The Center shall assist private industry in determining what 11 training services and programs are available, the steps necessary to provide 12 the training services and programs needed by the industry, and how long it 13 would take to develop the needed training services and programs. 14

15 SECTION 4. (a) The Department of Higher Education shall establish a 16 local advisory committee to provide guidance to the Center in implementing the 17 pilot project. The local advisory committee shall include representatives of 18 the Department of Higher Education, Arkansas Industrial Development 19 Commission, Henderson State University, Ouachita Technical College, 20 Arkadelphia High School, Malvern High School, and private industry. The 21 Department may include representatives of other appropriate groups and 22 organizations.

(b) The purpose or the local advisory committee shall be to assist the24 Center in determining the proper focus for industrial development.

(c) The local advisory committee shall make recommendations concerning:
(1) "soft skills" interpersonal relationships, such as discipline
and self reliance and an ability to communicate properly;

(2) "hard skills" such as skills required of workers by technicaltraining;

30 (3) apprenticeship and internship programs in students and31 potential workers; and

32 (4) other issues concerning the training and development of33 students and workers.

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35 SECTION 5. The Department of Higher Education shall establish 36 regulations governing the operation of the Center.

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2 SECTION 6. The Department of Higher Education may, as it deems 3 appropriate, establish additional pilot projects for workforce excellence in 4 other areas of the state. Each pilot project shall be established in 5 cooperation with institutions of education, private industry and other 6 appropriate groups in the area to be served. For each new pilot project the 7 Department of Higher Education shall establish a local advisory committee 8 which shall include representatives of institutions of education, private 9 industry and other appropriate groups. The duties of the local advisory 10 committee shall be the same as those provided in Section 4 of this act.

12 SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 13 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 14 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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16 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 17 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 18 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 19 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 20 act are declared to be severable.

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22 SECTION 9. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are 23 hereby repealed.

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SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, meeting in Extraordinary Session, that in order to attract high technology industry to this state that a highly trained workforce is essential; and that the provisions of this act will provide necessary resources for such workforce. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
