21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE	GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF T	HE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansa	ns Code Title 22, Chapter 8, Sub	chapter 2 is amended to add the
24	following new section:		
25	"22-8-210. Motor Veh	nicle Renovation.	
26	Funds deposited into t	he Motor Vehicle Acquisition Re	evolving Fund created by
27	Arkansas Code §19-5-1002 (a	n) and Arkansas Code §22-8-206	6 (b), which may be made
28	available for the purchase of n	notor vehicles for the Departmen	nt of Arkansas State Police, may
29	in addition be made available	and used for expenses associated	with the renovation of State
30	Police motor vehicles. If the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police determines		
31	the cost associated with renovating or reparing State Police motor vehicles is economically		
32	beneficial, he shall contract w	ith a qualified vendor and, when	invoiced, shall submit said
33	invoice to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State who shall direct payment from monies set aside		
34	in the Motor Vehicle Acquisit	ion Revolving Fund for the Depa	rtment of Arkansas State
35	Police."

1	SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are		
2	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision		
3	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.		
4			
5	SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or		
6	circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of		
7	this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end		
8	the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.		
9			
10	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.		
11			
12	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the		
13	Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that authorizing the payment of costs associated with the		
14	renovation of State Police motor vehicles from the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund		
15	is economically beneficial to the State of Arkansas, and the savings realized from such		
16	renovations will allow the Arkansas Department of State Police to replace high mileage and		
17	possibly dangerous motor vehicles sooner. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist		
18	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
19	safety shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.
