Arkansas Code 27-37-703 is amended to read as follows: "27-37-703. Effect of noncompliance. The failure to provide or use a 22 seat belt shall not be considered under any circumstances as evidence of 23 comparative or contributory negligence or failure to mitigate damages, nor 24 shall such failure be admissible as evidence in the trial of any civil action 25 with regard to negligence. Neither shall the failure to provide or use seat 26 belts be considered under any circumstances as evidence in any prosecution for 27 negligent homicide." 28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 29 30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 32 33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
