16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	SECTION 1. At any time an application is made for Workers'
19	Compensation, an employer shall require the applicant for compensation to
20	state whether or not the applicant has child support obligations, if the
21	obligations are current or past due, and to whom the obligations are payable.
22	The employer shall forward a copy of the application to the Arkansas Child
23	Support Enforcement Unit, Division of Economic and Medical Services,
24	Department of Human Services. The application shall also include the name of
25	the Workers' Compensation carrier and the name of the employer.
26	
27	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
28	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
29	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
30	
31	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
32	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
33	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
34	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
35	act are declared to be severable.
