BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
    SECTION 1. At any time an application is made for Workers'
Compensation, an employer shall require the applicant for compensation to
state whether or not the applicant has child support obligations, if the
obligations are current or past due, and to whom the obligations are payable.
    The employer shall forward a copy of the application to the Arkansas Child
Support Enforcement Unit, Division of Economic and Medical Services,
Department of Human Services. The application shall also include the name of
the Workers' Compensation carrier and the name of the employer.
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
