19	19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-2-207 is amended to read as follows:		
20	20 <b>"§3-2-207. Qualifications and oath of personnel.</b>		
21	(a) No person shall be appointed a member of the board or a director, agent, or		
22	22 employee of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division, the Alcoholic Beverage Contro	1	
23	23 Enforcement Division, or the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board who is not a citizen	of the	
24	24 United States and who has not resided in the State of Arkansas successively for two (	<b>2)</b> years	
25	25 immediately preceding the date of this appointment.		
26	26 (b) No person shall be so appointed who has been convicted of, or shall have	pleaded	
27	27 guilty to, a felony or any violation of any federal or state law concerning the manufac	ure or	
28	28 sale of alcoholic beverages or malt beverages prior or subsequent to the passage of th	is	
29	29 subchapter. Nor shall a person be appointed who has paid a fine or penalty in settlen	ent in ar	ıy
30	30 prosecution against him for any violation of such laws or who shall have forfeited his	bond to	
31	31 appear in court to answer charges for any such violation.		
32	32 (c) No appointee may, directly or indirectly, individually or as a member of a		
33	33 partnership, or as a shareholder of a corporation, have any interests whatsoever in the second se	ie	
34	34 manufacture, sale, or distribution of alcoholic beverages, nor receive any compensati	on or	
35	35 <b>profit therefrom.</b>		
36	36 (d) No appointee shall be an elected or appointed officer or employee of this s	state.	

1	(e) Each member of the board, director, and enforcement agent shall take and
2	subscribe to an oath that he will support and enforce the provisions of this subchapter, the
3	alcohol control laws of this state, the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and the
4	Constitution of the United States of America."
5	
6	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are
7	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
8	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
9	
10	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or
11	circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of
12	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end
13	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
14	
15	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
