16	"TO PROVIDE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SPOUSE AND
17	CHILDREN OF CERTAIN HIGHWAY AND
18	TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES KILLED
19	OR DISABLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY."

21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22	
23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-82-501 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof
24	a new subdivision to read as follows:
25	"(4) _State highway employee_ means any employee of the Arkansas State Highway and
26	Transportation Department who actively engages in highway maintenance, construction, or
27	traffic operations on the roadways and bridges of the state highway system while the roadways
28	and bridges are open for use by the traveling public."
29	
30	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 6-82-503 is hereby amended to read as follows:
31	"6-82-503. Entitlement.
32	(a) If any Arkansas law enforcement officer or full-time or volunteer fireman or state
33	highway employee suffers fatal injuries or wounds or becomes permanently and totally disabled
34	as a result of injuries or wounds which occurred in the performance of a hazardous duty within
35	the scope of his employment or which occurred en route to a location where a hazardous
36	situation existed, his children and spouse shall be entitled to an eight-semester scholarship

1 without cost, exclusive of books, food, school supplies, materials, and dues or fees for 2 extracurricular activities at any state-supported college or university of his choice within this ٦ state. (b) Scholarship benefits shall not accrue under this subchapter to any person if the 4 wounds or injuries suffered by any law enforcement officer, fireman or state highway employee 5 are self-inflicted or whose death is self-induced." 6 7 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-82-504 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8 "6-82-504. Claims for permanent and total disability. 9 Any law enforcement officer or municipal fireman or state highway employee claiming 10 permanent and total disability under this subchapter shall be qualified or disqualified for such 11 claim by the Arkansas State Claims Commission which shall have such jurisdiction and 12 authority as is granted to the commission under §§19-10-204 - 19-10-206 and 19-10-210." 13 14 15 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision 16 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 17 18 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or 19 circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of 20 21 the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. 2.2 23 SECTION 6.
