Wilson 6 For An Act To Be Entitled 7 "AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CIRCUIT-CHANCERY JUDGESHIP IN THE R SIXTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES." 9 10 Subtitle 11 "AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CIRCUIT-CHANCERY JUDGESHIP IN THE 12 SIXTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT." 13 14 15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 16 SECTION 1. (a) Effective July 1, 1993, there is hereby created in the 17 18 Sixth Judicial District an additional circuit-chancery judgeship, which shall 19 have jurisdiction in law, equity, and probate. 20 (b) The judge of the additional circuit-chancery judgeship created 21 herein shall devote such time as may be required to perform the duties of 22 judge of the juvenile division, which duties shall be the primary obligation 23 of the judge, and shall sit as judge of the circuit, chancery, or probate 24 court as time permits. 25 (c) The qualified electors of the Sixth Judicial District shall elect 26 the additional circuit-chancery judge created herein at the November 1994 27 general election to take office on January 1, 1995. The additional judge 28 shall be elected in the same manner and shall satisfy the same qualifications 29 for holding office and shall receive the same salary, expenses, and other 30 allowances as provided by law for judges of the circuit-chancery courts. The 31 judge shall serve for elected terms of four (4) years. (d) As soon as possible after the effective date of this act, the 33 Governor shall appoint a qualified person to temporarily fill the Sixth 34 Judicial District Circuit-Chancery judgeship created herein, and said person 35 shall serve until December 31, 1994, or until a successor has been elected and 36 qualified, whichever occurs last.

SECTION 2. The counties which comprise the Sixth Judicial District 2 3 shall provide courtroom and office facilities and supplies for the judge of 4 the circuit-chancery judgeship created by this act, which shall be paid out of 5 the county treasuries in the same manner as other demands against the 6 counties, out of funds appropriated by the respective quorum courts of the 7 counties for such purposes. g SECTION 3. There shall be provided for the judge of the circuit-9 10 chancery judgeship created by this act a court reporter, whose salary shall be 11 fixed and paid in the manner provided by law for court reporters of the 12 circuit-chancery courts of this state. 13 14 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 15 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 16 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 17 18 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 19 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 20 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 22 act are declared to be severable. 23 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 2.4 25 hereby repealed. 27 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General

28 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the caseload of the Sixth Judicial 29 District necessitates the appointment of additional circuit-chancery judges 30 immediately; and that this act so provides and should therefore be given 31 effect immediately. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and 32 this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, 33 health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its 34 passage and approval.
