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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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18	SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is hereby found and determined by the
19 20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the method of voting as outlined in Act 510 of 1987, which established the County Intergovernmental Cooperation Council is heavily
20	weighted in favor of cities and incorporated towns and due to this inequity has left the rural,
21	unincorporated areas of the several counties of Arkansas in danger of under representation. It
22	is further found and determined that it is the public policy of this state to provide full and equal
24	representation to all of its citizens at all levels and in all subdivisions of government and that
25	the provisions of this act are necessary for the furtherance of the goal of fair and equal
	representation.
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28	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated 14-27-102 is amended to read as follows:
29	"§ 14-27-102. Creation - Membership, etc.
30	(a) There is established within each county of this state a county intergovernmental

All other members of the council shall have one (1) vote for the local government jurisdiction they represent on the cooperation 3 council. 4 5 (2) The county clerk of each county shall serve as the secretary of the 6 cooperation council, shall preside over cooperation council meetings in the absence of the council chairman, and shall be responsible for writing and submitting all reports of the 7 cooperation council. 8 (c) The members of the cooperation council shall serve without compensation for their 9 services. 10 (d) A quorum shall consist of a majority of the council's membership and shall be necessary 11 to conduct its business." 12 13 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are 14 15 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 16 17 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or 18 circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of 19 the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end 20 the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. 21 22 SECTION 5.
