17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18	
19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 14-22-106 is amended to read as follows:
20	"14-22-106. Purchases exempted from soliciting bids.
21	The following listed commodities may be purchased without soliciting bids:
22	(1) Perishable foodstuffs for immediate use;
23	(2) Unprocessed feed for livestock and poultry;
24	(3) Advanced emergency medical services provided by a nonprofit corporation and
25	proprietary medicines when specifically requested by a professional employee;
26	(4) Books, manuals, periodicals, films, and copyrighted educational aids for use in
27	libraries and for other informational material for institutional purposes;
28	(5) Scientific equipment and parts therefor;
29	(6) Replacement parts and labor for repairs of machinery and equipment; (7)
30	Commodities available only from the federal government;
31	(8) Any commodities needed in instances in which an unforeseen and unavoidable
32	emergency has arisen in which human life, health, or public property is in jeopardy. However,
33	no such emergency purchase shall be approved unless a statement in writing shall be attached
34	to the purchase order describing the emergency necessitating the purchase of such commodity
35	without competitive bidding;
36	(9) Utility services, the rates for which are subject to regulation by a state agency or a

1 federal regulatory agency;

(10) Sand, gravel, soil, lumber, or used pipe;

3 (11) Used or secondhand motor vehicles, machinery, or equipment, except used or secondhand motor vehicles which have been under lease to a county when such vehicles had 4 fewer than eighteen thousand (18,000) miles of use, may not be purchased by the county when 5 it has been used eighteen thousand (18,000) miles or more except upon competitive bids as 6 provided for in this chapter; 7 (12) Machinery, equipment, facilities, or other personal property purchased or 8 acquired for, or in connection with, the securing and developing of industry under or pursuant 9 to the provisions of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 49 [repealed], Arkansas Code 10 14-164-201 et seq., or any other provision of law pertaining to the securing and developing of 11 industry; 12 (13) Registered livestock to be used for breeding purposes; 13 14 (14) Motor fuels; 15 (15) Motor vehicles, equipment, machinery, material, or supplies offered for sale at 16 public auction or through a process requiring sealed bids; and All goods and services which are regularly provided to state agencies and county 17 (16) government by the Arkansas Department of Corrections various penal industries." 18 19 20 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are 21 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 22 23 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or 24 25 circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end 26 the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. 27 28 SECTION 4.
