13	"TO PRESCRIBE ACCEPTABLE METHODS FOR THE
14	DISPOSAL OF FOWL CARCASSES."
15	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-40-401 is amended to read as follows:
19	"2-40-401. Definitions.
20	As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
21	(1) _Approved incineration_ means a method of incineration approved by the
22	commission;
23	(2) _Commission_ means the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission created by
24	§ 2-33-101;
25	(3) _Fowl carcasses_ means carcasses of fowl which died as the result of sickness,
26	suffocation, accident, or from any cause other than intentional slaughter;
27	(4) _Responsible person_ means the person who has the direct responsibility for the
28	day-to-day care of the fowl involved;
29	(5) _Fowl_ shall include all domesticated avian species."
30	
31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 2-40-403 is amended to read as follows:
32	"2-40-403. Requirements.
33	The Commission shall, by regulation, specify acceptable methods for the disposal of
34	fowl carcasses including but not limited to: (1) composting of carcasses; (2) cremation or
35	incineration; (3) extrusion; (4) on-farm freezing; (5) rendering; and (6) cooking for swine
36	feed."

2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 2-40-404 is amended to read as follows:
3	"2-40-404. Specifications.
4	The Commission shall, by regulation, specify acceptable methods of the disposal of fowl
5	carcasses in the event of a major die-off."
6	
7	SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are
8	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
9	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
10	
11	SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or
12	circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of
13	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end
14	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
15	
16	SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
17	
18	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
19	Assembly that eliminating the use of disposal pits is essential for effectively and efficiently
20	protecting the health and well being of the public. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
21	to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety $\frac{1}{2}$
22	shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
