## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 56 OF TITLE 5 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION TO ESTABLISH FURTHER PENALTIES FOR FOOD STAMP TRAFFICKING; TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE §5-56-102; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

 "TO ESTABLISH FURTHER PENALTIES FOR FOOD STAMP TRAFFICKING AND TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE §5-56-102."BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 56 of Title 5 of the Arkansas Code is hereby amended by adding a new section to read as follows:
"5-56-105. In addition to the penalties set forth in this chapter, any recipient of food stamps found guilty of a violation set forth in this chapter shall be ineligible for further participation in the food stamp program, as follows:
(1) For a period of six (6) months, upon the first occasion of any offense;
(2) For a period of one (1) year, upon the second occasion of any offense;
(3) Permanently, upon the third occasion of any offense."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
