19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Whenever any agency of this state or of any county, municipality, or
22	school district, or other local taxing unit or improvement district enters into a contract covered
23	by the provisions of Arkansas Code §§ 22-9-202 - 22-9-204 for the making of repairs or
24	alterations or the erection of buildings or for the making of any other improvements, or for the
25	construction or improvement of highways, roads, streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, drainage or
26	sewer projects, or for any other construction project in which the public work or public
27	improvement construction project involves any trench or excavation which equals or exceeds
28	five (5) feet in depth, the agency, county, municipality, school district, local taxing unit or
29	improvement district shall require:
30	(1) the current edition of Occupational Safety and Health Administration
31	Standard for Excavation and Trenches Safety System, 29 CFR 1926, Subpart P, be
32	specifically incorporated into the specifications for the project; and
33	(2) the contract bid form to include a separate pay item for trench or
34	excavation safety systems and be included in the base bid.
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36	SECTION 2 . In the event a contractor fails to <i>complete a separate pay item in</i>

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1	<i>accordance</i> with the applicable provisions of Section 1 of this act, the agency, county,
2	municipality, school district, local taxing unit or improvement district shall declare that the
3	bid fails to comply fully with the provisions of the specifications and bid documents and will be
4	considered invalid as a non-responsive bid. <i>The owners of the above stated project shall notify</i>
5	the State Department of Labor (Safety Division) of the award of a contract covered by this
6	act.
7	
8	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature are
9	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
10	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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12	SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or
13	circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of
14	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end
15	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
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17	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
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19	SECTION 6. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth
20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the well-being of Arkansas' craft workers are
21	unnecessarily exposed to the hazards of trench excavation and the immediate passage of this
22	act is necessary in order to protect the health and safety of the Arkansas worker. Therefore, an
23	emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the immediate
24	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and
25	after its passage and approval.
