Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated §8-5-319 is hereby amended to read as 22 follows: 23 "8-5-319. Failure, neglect, or refusal to pay. In the event any municipality shall fail, 2.4 neglect, or refuse to pay any installment of principal or interest found to be ninety (90) or 25 more days past legally due in accordance with the written instrument for the repayment of its 2.6 bonds, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness purchased with moneys in the Construction 2.7 Assistance Revolving Loan Fund established by Arkansas Code §15-5-901, §1 (the Fund ), or its successor fund, the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology, after first 29 notifying the municipality of such facts, is hereby authorized to certify such facts to the State 30 Treasurer, the State Auditor, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Upon certification of 31 the name of the municipality and the amount which is ninety (90) or more days past due, the 32 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State are hereby 34 directed to withhold from the municipality's share of general revenue turnback, as such share is defined in the Revenue Stabilization Law, Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated § 19-5-101 et 36 seq., as the same may be amended from time to time, the amount so certified and to transfer

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| 5  | SECTION 2. The amendments made by this act shall also apply to bonds, notes, and                                   |
| 6  | other evidences of indebtedness of municipalities purchased prior to the effective date of this                    |
| 7  | act with moneys in the Fund or the Construction Grants Revolving Loan Fund established by                          |
| 8  | Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated §19-5-944.   |
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| 10 | SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are  |
| 11 | amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision                                   |
| 12 | Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.   |
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| 14 | SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or                                |
| 15 | circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of                 |
| 16 | the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end                    |
| 17 | the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.   |
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| 19 | SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.                               |
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| 21 | SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  |
| 22 | General Assembly that there is an immediate need for improvements to public wastewater                             |
| 23 | systems in the state that are operated by various municipalities and that the provisions of this                   |
| 24 | act are immediately needed in order to provide an additional method of financing such                              |
| 25 | improvements by such municipalities in connection with federal programs. Therefore, an                             |
| 26 | emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the                     |
| 27 | public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and                   |
| 28 | approval.  |
