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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 51 is amended to add a new subchapter	l•

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25	<b>6-51-7</b> 01. Title.	
26	The title of this subchapter shall be the _Model Vocational-Technical Education	
27	Resource Center Act of 1993	
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29	6-51-702. Definitions.	
30	For the purpose of this subchapter _resource center_ means the Vocational-Technic	al
31	Education Resource Center created by this subchapter.	
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33	6-51-703. Model Vocational-Technical Education Resource Center established -	
34	Functions.	
35	(a) There is established a model resource center for a system of multi-county	
36	vocational and technical education services. The model resource center shall be located with	nin

1	the North East Arkansas Education Services Cooperative service area, established pursuant to
2	Arkansas Code 6-13-1002 et seq. The resource center shall be an intermediate service unit in
3	the state_s vocational and technical education system for public schools and other vocational,
4	<i>technical, or adult</i> programs in the state and as such shall be eligible to receive and expend
5	funds from state and federal governments, school districts, and other public or private sources.
6	(b) The resource center established by this subchapter will provide to school districts
7	and <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> which choose to use them assistance in:
8	(1) Meeting or exceeding accreditation standards and equalizing vocational and
9	technical educational opportunities;
10	(2) Using vocational and technical educational resources more effectively
11	through cooperation; and
12	(3) <b>Promoting coordination vocational and technical programs and services.</b>
13	
14	6-51-704. Board of directors.
15	(a) The resource center shall be governed by a board of directors consisting of nine (9)
16	members to be composed as follows:
17	(1) Five (5) members shall be representative of school districts in the service
18	area;
19	(2) Two (2) members shall be representative of business or industry in the
20	service area; and
21	(3) Two (2) members shall be representative of <i>other vocational, technical, or</i>
22	<i>adult programs</i> serving the area.
23	(b) The selection of board members shall be made in such a manner so that as near as
24	possible each county in the area has equal representation.
25	(c) The initial board shall be selected by a majority vote of the superintendents of the
26	school districts in the area from a list of nominees submitted by the North East Arkansas
27	Vocational-Technical Education Advisory Council. Thereafter, vacancies shall be filled by a
28	majority vote of the remaining board members of the resource center.
29	(d) The board of directors of the resource center shall function as a public corporate
30	body, shall meet at least four (4) times each year, and shall exercise general fiduciary
31	responsibilities for the resource center with regard to policies and practices which guard the
32	integrity of the <i>center</i> and maintain public trust in its operation.
33	(e) The responsibilities of the board, consistent with funds available, shall include, but
34	not be limited to:
35	(1) Employment of a director of the resource center who shall serve as the

1	nonvoting executive officer of the board of directors;
2	(2) Establishment of policies and procedures for the operation and
3	management of the resource center which shall be in written form and shall be filed with the
4	State Board of Vocational Education;
5	(3) Preparation of an annual budget estimating income and expenditures for
6	programs and services in accordance with procedures <i>approved</i> by the State Board of
7	Vocational Education;
8	(4) Receipt and expenditure of funds needed to provide programs and services
9	in the area;
10	(5) Making such surveys or other inquiries which may be required to determine
11	the service needs of school districts, <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> , and
12	business and industry in the area served by the resource center and developing plans to provide
13	such needed services;
14	(6) Employment, upon the recommendations of the director of the resource
15	center, of such personnel as may be required to provide the services requested in the area;
16	(7) Cooperation with school districts, <i>other vocational, technical, or adult</i>
17	<i>programs</i> , business and industry, and other agencies to provide programs and services for
18	children and adults residing within the areas;
19	(8) Renting, leasing, or receiving by gift such facilities and buildings as may be
20	required to provide authorized programs and services; and
21	(9) Carrying out such other duties which may be required for the efficient
22	operation of the resource center for which the board is responsible. (f) The board may
23	<i>petition the State Board of Vocational Education to</i> establish a vocational center which will
24	provide, consistent with funds available, vocational education opportunities to students.
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26	6-51-705. Personnel generally.
27	(a) Personnel of the resource center shall be employed in accordance with laws, rules,
28	regulations, and procedures applicable to the school districts of this state.
29	(b) Certificate requirements shall be the same as those expected of persons holding
30	similar positions in local school districts. However, the Director of Vocational and Technical
31	Education may grant a waiver from this subsection in exceptional circumstances.
32	(c) Termination or contract nonrenewal of resource center personnel shall be as
33	provided by law for the school district personnel.
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**6-51-706. Agency personnel.** 

1	With the approval of the board of directors of the resource center, the Director of
2	Vocational-Technical Education and the Director of General Education may assign state
3	educational agency personnel to the resource center.
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5	6-51-707. Programs and services.
6	(a) The programs and services of the resource center shall be based upon the needs of
7	the school districts and <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> included in its service
8	area and upon the educational priorities of the state.
9	(b) The resource center may provide vocational and technical educational programs
10	and services which the State Board of Vocational Education may approve or which school
11	districts or <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> may support with local funds.
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13	6-51-708. Participation of local school districts - Contracts.
14	(a) No school district or <i>other vocational, technical, or adult program</i> shall be
15	required to participate in any service.
16	(b) School districts and <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> may enter into
17	contract with the resource center for services supported partially or completely by funds of the
18	school district or <i>other vocational, technical, or adult program</i> .
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20	6-51-7 <i>09</i> . Funding of resource center.
21	(a) As a public agency, the resource center shall be eligible to receive and expend
22	public and private funds.
23	(b) School districts and <i>other vocational, technical, or adult programs</i> may contract
24	with the resource center for services and part-time personnel to be supported in whole or in
25	part by local funds, but no school district or <i>other vocational, technical, or adult program</i> shall
26	be assessed a membership fee.
27	(c) Categorical state or federal funds may be assigned to the resource center upon
28	approval of its board of directors and under conditions set by the State Board of Vocational
29	Education or the State Board of Education.
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31	<b>6-51-710.</b> Policies and procedures - Expenditures, reports, and audits.
32	(a) In consultation with the State Board of Vocational Education, the policies,
33	procedures, <i>and a strategic plan for the operation of</i> the resource center shall be <i>developed</i>
34	<i>and</i> filed with the State Board of Vocational Education <i>prior to the start up of the center</i> .
35	These documents shall be updated annually and filed with the State Board of Vocational

1 *Education* on or before June 1 of each year. (b) Reports of receipts and expenditures shall also be filed with the State Board 2 of Vocational Education on forms provided and time schedules set by the Director of 3 Vocational-Technical Education. These reports shall contain, but not be limited to, an 4 itemization of administrative and programmatic expenditures. Expenditures shall be reported 5 in accordance with uniform accounting procedures adopted by the Vocational and Technical 6 Education Division. 7 (c) The resource center shall be subject to annual audits by the Legislative 8 Joint Auditing Committee. 9 10 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are 11 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision 12 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 13 14 15 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of 16 the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end 17 the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. 18 19 20 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed. 21 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 22 General Assembly that the establishment of a vocational-technical education resource center, 23 as provided for in this act, is essential if needed improvements are to be made in vocational 24 education programs in this state and that immediate action is necessary if the Vocational-25 Technical Education Resource Center is formed and ready for operation by the beginning of 26 the 1993-94 school year. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be 28 in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. 29 30 31 32 33 34 /s/Thomas G.
