## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REPEAL ARKANSAS CODE 17-89-404 TO ABOLISH THE OPTOMETRIC THERAPEUTIC COMMITTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle
"AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE OPTOMETRIC THERAPEUTIC COMMITTEE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-89-404 is hereby repealed and the Optometric Therapeutic Committee is hereby abolished and all rights, duties and responsibilities of the Committee are delegated to the Arkansas State Board of Optometry.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the purposes for which the Optometric Therapeutic Committee were created have been accomplished and that the continuation of the Committee
serves no useful purpose. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
