17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §25-8-101(d) is hereby amended to read as follows:
20	"(d) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration with the advice
21	and consent of the Governor, shall appoint the heads of the respective divisions. The director
22	may appoint an Administrative Assistant for Revenue to serve as the Commissioner of
23	Revenues. All other personnel of the Department of Finance and Administration shall be
	employed by and serve at the pleasure of the Director of the Department of Finance and
25	Administration, provided that nothing in this section shall be so construed as to reduce any
26	• • •
27	any civil service or merit system."
28	
29	SECTION 2. Ark. Code Ann. §25-8-101 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection
30	(f) to read as follows:
31	"(f) For the purposes of the tax, driver's license, and motor vehicle registration and
32	licensing laws the term _Director_ shall mean the Director of the Department of Finance and
33	Administration, the Commissioner of Revenues, or his authorized agent. The Commissioner of

1	SECTION 3. Ark. Code Ann. §26-18-104(2) is hereby amended by to read as follows:
2	"_Director_ means the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration,
3	State of Arkansas or the Commissioner of Revenues, or his authorized agent;"
4	
5	SECTION 4. Ark. Code Ann. §26-18-405(d)(4) is hereby amended by adding a new
6	subsection (C) to read as follows:
7	"(C) The director may within twenty (20) days of the mailing of the decision, revise the
8	decision of the hearing officer regardless of whether the taxpayer has requested a revision. If
9	the director revises the decision of the hearing officer sustaining any portion of an assessment
10	then a notice of final assessment, as provided by §26-18-401 shall be made upon the final
11	determination of the director. The taxpayer may not request revision of a decision issued by
12	the director under this section."
13	
14	SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are
15	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
16	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
17	
18	SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or
19	circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of
20	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end
21	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
22	
23	SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
