Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated § 26-75-604 is hereby amended by 2.3 adding new subsection 26-75-604(c), as follows: 2.4 25 "(c) When the electors of any city levy a gross receipts tax as set forth in subsection (b) of this section and when the electors of that city have pledged some or all of the proceeds 2.6 thereof to the repayment of bonds, as set forth in 26.75-606(b)(1) and (2) or 26.75-606(b)(1)613(a)(2), the proceeds so pledged shall be deposited in the city advertising and promotion fund and distributed by the city advertising and promotion commission in accordance with the 29 pledge and enactment of the electors." 30 31 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated § 26-75-606(b)(2) is hereby 32 amended to read: 33 "(2) Funds credited to the city advertising and promotion fund, pursuant to this 34 subchapter, may be used, spent or pledged by the commission, in addition to all other purposes 35 prescribed in this subchapter, on and for the construction, reconstruction, repair,

1	maintenance, improvements, equipping, and operation of public recreation facilities in said
2	city, including but not limited to facilities constituting city parks, and also for the payment of
3	the principal of, interest on, and fees and expenses in connection with, bonds, as provided in
4	this subchapter, in the manner as shall be determined by the city advertising and promotion
5	commission for the purpose of such payment."

7	SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are
8	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
9	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

L1	SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or
L2	$circumstance\ is\ held\ invalid,\ such\ invalidity\ shall\ not\ affect\ other\ provisions\ or\ applications\ of$
L3	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end
L4	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
L5	
L6	SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
L7	
L8	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
L9	Assembly that there is urgent need to revise current law relating to the advertising and
20	promotion commissions of municipalities and relating to the authorized uses of local revenues
21	derived from local sales taxes levied on gross receipts of hotels, motels, and restaurants, and
22	that the provisions of this act are designed to accomplish this purpose and are immediately
23	needed in order to clarify the methods of operating of such commissions and administration of
24	such taxes. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary
25	for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from
26	and after its passage and approval.
