HOUSE BILL 1462

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 2-19-202 (a) TO REMOVE THE
9 RESTRICTION ON A GUARANTEED ANALYSIS OF A *SPECIALTY*
10 FERTILIZER FROM INDICATING FRACTIONAL UNITS OF PRIMARY
11 PLANT FOOD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT TO REMOVE THE RESTRICTION ON FRACTIONAL
15 UNITS OF PRIMARY PLANT FOOD FROM APPEARING IN
16 THE GUARANTEED ANALYSIS OF A *SPECIALTY*
17 FERTILIZER."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION I. Subsection (a) of Arkansas Code § 2-19-202 is hereby amended to read
22 as follows:

23 "(a)(1) All manufacturers, jobbers, and manipulators of commercial fertilizers and of
24 fertilizer materials to be used in the manufacture of fertilizer, who may desire to sell or offer
25 for sale in Arkansas fertilizer and fertilizer materials, shall first file for registration with the
26 State Plant Board, upon forms furnished by the board. The forms shall include the name of the
27 brand of each fertilizer, fertilizer materials, or chemicals which they may desire to sell in the
28 state, either by themselves or their agents, together with the names and addresses of the
29 manufacturers or manipulators, and such other information as may be required by the board
30 in its regulations. (2) A registrant shall not be required to register each grade of
31 fertilizer that is formulated but shall report the mixed formulations on a monthly basis as
32 required by § 2-19-209.

33 (3) All registrations must be approved by the board or its authorized agent
34 before being effective.

35 (4) Registrations may be cancelled by the board for repeated flagrant violations
36 of this subchapter, after notice and a hearing.
