13	"TO RECLASSIFY SIXTEENTH DISTRICT PROSECUTOR
14	FROM DIVISION A TO DIVISION B."

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	SECTION 1. Retroactive to January 1, 1993, the Sixteenth Judicial District Division
19	A Prosecuting Attorney shall be reclassified as a Division B Judicial District Prosecuting
20	Attorney.
21	
22	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are
23	amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
24	Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
25	
26	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or
27	circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of
28	the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end
29	the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
30	
31	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
32	
33	SECTION 5. It is hereby found and determined by the General Assembly that the
34	Sixteenth Judicial District would operate more effectively with a Class B prosecutor and that
35	it is no longer necessary for the Prosecuting Attorney to continue as a full time prosecutor.
36	This act is necessary to assure efficient administration of justice in this circuit. Therefore an

1	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act, being necessary for the immediate
2	preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect upon passage
3	and approval.
