1	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General		
2	Assembly that no attorney at law resides within Scott County who can legally serve as the		
3	deputy prosecuting attorney for the county; that this act authorizes a non-resident of Scott		
4	County to serve as the deputy prosecuting attorney for Scott County; and that this act should		
5	be given effect immediately in order to give the prosecuting attorney of the Fifteenth Judicial		
6	District the authority to provide services within the district as soon as possible. Therefore, a		
7	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate		
8	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and		
9	after its passage and approval.
