22	employee of a county or municipal government or land owner selling exclusivel	У
23	to these government entities to comply with any of the provisions of this	
24	subchapter when engaged in open-cut mining for the construction,	
25	reconstruction, improvement or maintenance of streets and highways or	
26	private road, street, driveway or highway, or other public projects of a	
27	county or municipality when it is conducted under the authority of said	
28	government for such activities, and on lands for which the county or municipa	11
29	government has established rights. The county and municipal governments shall	.1
30	remove topsoil and overburden and store it on mining site. Upon completion o	£
31	mining the site shall be graded such that no slope will be steeper than one	
32	(1) foot vertical to three (3) feet horizontal and the topsoil shall be

36	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent natur	·e

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 8 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10
11 hereby repealed.

         SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
14 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the reclamation and restoration of land
15 affected by open-cut mining operations are essential to the preservation for
16 productive use of the land resources of this state, however, the construction
17 and maintenance of streets and highways are also a very productive use of land
18 resources and such uses should be exempt from the provisions of the "Arkansas
19 Open-Cut Land Reclamation Act" when conducted under the auspices of the
20 Arkansas Highway Department or any county or municipal government. Therefore,
21 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the
22 immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in
23 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
