Legislative Intent. It is the intent of the Arkansas 23 24 General Assembly to make available to the members of the Arkansas Teachers 25 Retirement System, a school employees individual retirement account plan and 26 any other tax deferral plan permitted by federal law, to enable the members to 27 conveniently and economically receive the fullest benefits offered by federal 28 tax law as it relates to tax deferred savings plans for school employees 29 covered by a mandatory public retirement plan. 30 31 SECTION 2. (a) There is hereby created a fund or funds which shall be 32 known collectively as the School Employees Individual Retirement Account Fund The School Employees Individual Retirement Account Fund shall be 34 administered by the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teachers Retirement 35 System. 36 (b) The Board of Trustees is hereby empowered and authorized to

1 promulgate all necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of 2 this act, and to define terms, words and phrases to be used in implementing 3 investment plans and accounts for the school employees, provided the rules and 4 regulations shall conform to the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code. 5 The Board of Trustees may in its discretion adopt one (1) or more tax deferred 6 savings plans authorized by the federal government if it finds that doing so 7 will offer substantial tax benefits to school employees covered under the 8 provisions of this act. 9 SECTION 3. The SEIRAF program shall be available to all employees in 11 the state of Arkansas who are members of the Arkansas Teachers Retirement 12 System. Participation in this fund shall be on a strictly voluntary basis 13 under the rules and regulations which shall be adopted by the Board of 14 Trustees and in accordance with the provisions contained in the Internal 15 Revenue Code as it relates to individual retirement accounts for public 16 employees. Any person who shall become ineligible for participation in the 17 SEIRAF due to the termination of his employment with an eligible employer may 18 leave his contributions on account with the SEIRAF. However, no further 19 contributions may be accepted on his or her account unless the person shall 20 become reemployed by an eligible employer. 21 22 SECTION 4. All investments under the SEIRAF program shall be made 23 pursuant to the same authority and same restrictions that govern the 24 investment of funds of the Arkansas Teachers Retirement System. 25 Contributions to the School Employees Individual Retirement 26 SECTION 5. 27 Account Fund may be deducted from each participating employees compensation 28 and transmitted to the SEIRAF in accordance with any limitations imposed by 29 federal tax law for any tax deferred savings plan offered pursuant to the 30 provisions of this act and pursuant to the rules and regulations as shall be 31 promulgated by the Board. 32 33 SECTION 6. The administrative cost for the operation of the School 34 Employees Individual Retirement Account Fund shall be provided through

35 investment earnings on contributions to the fund. No state funds shall be

         SECTION 7. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
 4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
 5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 8. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
 8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
10 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
11 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 9. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
13
14 hereby repealed.
