25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-17-205(c) is hereby amended to read as
26	follows:
27	"(c)(1) The Governor shall appoint one (1) person who is the parent of
28	a blind student and one (1) person who is the parent of a deaf student to
29	serve as advisory nonvoting members of the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas
30	School for the Blind and the Arkansas School for the Deaf.
31	(2) The term of office of the advisory members shall be the same
32	as the term of office of the other members of the board. Any vacancy arising
33	in an advisory position shall be filled in the same manner as those of other
34	vacancies arising in the membership of the board.
35	(3) A state employee who is a parent or a legal guardian of a

1 Deaf shall be eligible to serve as a regular or advisory member of the board." SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 4 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 5 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 8 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 9 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 11 act are declared to be severable.
