20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 10-3-301 (a) is amended to read as follows:
23	"(a) An ad interim committee of the General Assembly is hereby
24	established as a Legislative Council, which shall consist of thirty-six (36)
25	members to be selected as follows:
26	(1) The Senate of the General Assembly shall select sometime

Arkansas Code 10-3-403 (a) is amended to read as follows: 6 7 "(a) The Legislative Joint Auditing Committee shall consist of thirty-six (36) members of the General Assembly, to be selected as follows: 8 9 (1) Sometime before adjournment of each regular session, the Senate 10 shall select twelve (12) members, with three (3) to be chosen from each of the 11 four (4) congressional districts in effect on January 1, 1987, by caucus of 12 the Senators residing in the respective congressional districts. The House of Representatives shall select twenty (20) members in 13 (2)14 accordance with the procedures prescribed by House rules. 15 The Speaker of the House, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, (3) 16 and the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Arkansas Legislative Council shall 17 be ex officio members of the committee and shall enjoy all the rights and 18 privileges of other members of the committee." 19 20 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 10-3-502(a) and (b), as amended by Act 832 of 21 1991, are amended to read as follows: 22 "(a) The Joint Budget Committee shall consist of twenty (20) members 23 and eight (8) alternate members of the House of Representatives and twenty (20) members of the Senate. 24 25 (b) The House shall select the members and their alternates in 26 accordance with the procedure prescribed by House rules." 27 28 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 31 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 32 33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

         SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are

 4 hereby repealed.

         SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
 6
 7 Assembly that this act affects the method of selection of members of the House
 8 of Representatives to the Legislative Council, Legislative Joint Auditing
9 Committee and the Joint Budget Committee; and that this act is immediately
10 necessary to provide for the proper selection of such members during the
11 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to
12 exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
13 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
14 after its passage and approval.
