18	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated 5-39-101 is amended to read as follows:
19 20	"5-39-101. Definitions.
21	As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
22	(1) Residential occupiable structure means a vehicle, building, or
23	other structure:
24	(A) Where any person lives; or
25	(B) Which is customarily used for overnight accommodation of
	persons whether or not a person is actually present. Each unit of a
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29	(2) _Commercial occupiable structure_ means a vehicle, building, or
30	other structure:
31	(A) Where any person carries on a business or other calling; or
32	(B) Where people assemble for purposes of business, government,
33	education, religion, entertainment, or public transportation.
34	(3) _Premises_ means occupiable structures and any real property.
35	(4) _Enter or remain unlawfully_ means to enter or remain in or upon
36	premises when not licensed or privileged to do so. A person who enters or

- 1 remains in or upon premises that are at the time open to the public does so
- 2 with license and privilege, regardless of his purpose, unless he defies a
- 3 lawful order not to enter or remain personally communicated to him by the
- 4 owner of the premises or some other person authorized by the owner. A license
- 5 or privilege to enter or remain in or upon premises only part of which are
- 6 open to the public is not a license or privilege to enter or remain in a part
- 7 of the premises not open to the public. A person who enters or remains upon
- 8 unimproved and apparently unused land not fenced or otherwise enclosed in a
- 9 manner designed to exclude intruders does so with license and privilege unless
- 10 notice not to enter or remain is personally communicated to him by the owner
- 11 or some person authorized by the owner, or unless notice is given by posting
- 12 in a conspicuous manner.
- 13 (5) Vehicle means any craft or device designed for the transportation
- 14 of people or property across land or water or through the air."

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- 16 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated 5-39-201 is amended to read as
- 17 follows:
- 18 "5-39-201. Burglary.
- 19 (a) A person commits residential burglary if he enters or remains
- 20 unlawfully in a residential occupiable structure of another person with the
- 21 purpose of committing therein any offense punishable by imprisonment.
- 22 (b) A person commits commercial burglary if he enters or remains
- 23 unlawfully in a commercial occupiable structure of another with the purpose of
- 24 committing therein any offense punishable by imprisonment.
- 25 (c) Residential burglary is a Class B felony. Commercial burglary is a
- 26 Class C felony."

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- 28 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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- 32 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
- 34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
- 35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

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1 act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 4 hereby repealed.
