ACT 560 OF 1993
HOUSE BILL 1799

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR
9 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY; TO
10 REPEAL ACT 426 OF 1991; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR
15 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. The deputy prosecuting attorney of Lafayette County shall
20 receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor
21 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) as may be prescribed by the quorum
22 court and to be paid in equal monthly amounts out of the general revenues of
23 the county. In addition the deputy prosecuting attorney shall be paid an
24 amount not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor more than twelve
25 thousand dollars (\$12,000) per year as an office expense allowance to be set
26 by the quorum court and to be paid from the general revenue fund of the county
27 in equal monthly amounts.

29 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January
30 1, 1993.

32 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 4. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

5

6 SECTION 5. (a) Act 426 of 1991 is hereby repealed.

7 (b) All other laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8 hereby repealed.

9

10 SECTION 6. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the
11 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the salary of the
12 deputy prosecuting attorney of Lafayette County is insufficient to adequately
13 compensate the person filling the position; that the expense allowance is
14 presently insufficient to reimburse the deputy prosecutor for expenses
15 incurred in connection with the office and that the immediate passage of this
16 act is necessary to provide the quorum court the necessary flexibility to
17 adjust the salary level and expense account of the deputy prosecuting attorney
18 of Lafayette County. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
19 this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
20 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
21 and approval.
