Arkansas Code Annotated 14-202-112 (a) (1) (A) is amended to 19 20 read as follows: "(a)(1)(A) Bonds issued hereunder shall be executed by the manual or 22 facsimile signatures of the mayor and clerk of the municipality." 23 2.4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 25 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 26 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 27 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 2.8 29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 30 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 31 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 32 act are declared to be severable. 33 34 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 35 hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
 1
 2 Assembly that the existing law prescribing the requirements for the execution
 3 of joint municipal electric power generation revenue bonds by municipalities
 4 is unduly restrictive; that a provision broadening such law to allow for
 5 execution wholly by means of facsimile signatures is desirable in order to
 6 provide needed flexibility to municipalities; that there is an emergency need
 7 for such a provision and that an enactment of the measure will remedy this
 8 situation. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act
 9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
11 approval.
