For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -
10 EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION WHICH WILL BE SUPPLEMENTAL
11 AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 61 OF
12 1993 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR
13 OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE
17 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION
18 DIVISION."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES . There is hereby established for the
23 Department of Education - Educational Television Division for the 1993-95
24 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall be
25 supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of Act
26 61 of 1993 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
28 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
29 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
30 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
31 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
32 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
33 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

9 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the

10 Department of Education - Educational Television Division to be payable from

11 the Educational Television Fund Account, for personal services, operating

12 expenses, and acquisition of a satellite uplink system by the Department of

13 Education - Educational Television Division for the biennial period ending

14 June 30, 1995, the following:

29 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education

30 - General Education Division, to be payable from the federal funds as

31 designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for Grants and Aid of the

32 Department of Education - General Education Division - Elementary and

33 Secondary Education which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds

34 appropriated in Section 5, Item (05) of Act 1120 of 1991, for the remainder of

35 the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the sum \$38,000,000.

2 SECTION 4. *The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish upon*
3 *request for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division a*
4 *special appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional*
5 *items. When the Department of Education - Educational Television Division*
6 *wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses appropriation to the*
7 *promotional items line, the AETN Commission shall approve the request and*
8 *forward it to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing.*

10 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
11 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
12 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
13 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
16 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
17 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

19

20 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
22 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
23 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28

29 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
34 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
35 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

7 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
10 the effectiveness of this Act is essential to the operation of the agency for
11 which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an
12 extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act
13 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
14 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to
15 exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
16 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
17 after *its passage and approval*.
