For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO TRANSFER THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT UNIT IN
9 THE ECONOMIC AND MEDICAL SERVICES DIVISION OF THE
10 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
11 AND ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION AS THE
12 OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR PERSONAL
13 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
14 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION -
15 OFFICE OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR OTHER
16 PURPOSES."

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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25 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the*
26 *Department of Finance and Administration-Revenue Services Division - Office of*
27 *Child Support Enforcement for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum*
28 *number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions*
29 *of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201*
30 *et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,*
31 *however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set*
32 *out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform*
33 *Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions*
34 *authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular*
35 *Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its*
36 *successor.*

15 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated to the

16 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division - Office

17 of Child Support Enforcement, to be payable from the Child Support Enforcement

18 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of

19 Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division - Office of Child

20 Support Enforcement for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the

21 following:

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2 SECTION 3. FUND ESTABLISHED. There is hereby established on the books
3 of the State Treasurer, State Auditor, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a
4 fund to be known as the "Child Support Enforcement Fund". Such fund shall
5 consist of the state share of funds collected from Aid to Families with
6 Dependent Children (AFDC) by the Office of Child Support Enforcement, all
7 incentive payments received from the federal government for both AFDC and non-
8 AFDC collections, all cost-recovery from withholding from collections and all
9 amounts received from the federal government as reimbursement.

10

11 SECTION 4. The Child Support Enforcement Unit of the Division of
12 Economic and Medical Services of the Department of Human Services is hereby
13 transferred by a Type 2 transfer pursuant to Arkansas Code 25-2-105 to the
14 *Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division* and shall
15 *be known as the Office of Child Support Enforcement.*

16

17 SECTION 5. TRANSFERS. Upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of
18 the State and the review of the Legislative Council, the Department of Finance
19 and Administration - Revenue Services Services Division - Office of Child
20 Support Enforcement is hereby authorized to transfer any appropriations made
21 in any line item or subclassification of Maintenance and General Operation in
22 Section 2 of this act to any other line item or subclassification of
23 Maintenance and General Operation in Section 2 of this act. Such transfers
24 shall be made according to procedures established by the Chief Fiscal Officer
25 of the State.

26

27 SECTION 6. LOANS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is hereby
28 authorized to make such loans as may be necessary from the Budget
29 Stabilization Trust Fund to the Child Support Enforcement Fund to meet the
30 obligations of the Office of Child Support Enforcement within the Department
31 of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division. Such loans shall
32 be repaid by the biennial period ending June 30, 1995.

33

34 SECTION 7. All powers, duties, functions, records, property, and funds
35 administered or provided by other support divisions within the Department of

1 *Human Services shall be transferred to the Office of Child Support Enforcement*
2 *of the Department of Finance and Administration Revenue Services Division upon*
3 *the effective date of the transfer.*

4

5 *SECTION 8. The Department of Human Services and the Department of*
6 *Computer Services shall grant access to and provide information as determined*
7 *by the Office of Child Support Enforcement necessary to successfully*
8 *accomplish their mission.*

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10 *SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds*
11 *authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency*
12 *and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and*
13 *the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and*
14 *Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary*
15 *Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control*
16 *laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the*
17 *Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be*
18 *strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.*

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20 *SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General*
21 *Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations*
22 *contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which*
23 *this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive*
24 *Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget*
25 *manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or*
26 *summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative*
27 *Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.*

28

29 *SECTION 11. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and*
30 *permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the*
31 *Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.*

32

33 *SECTION 12. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the*
34 *application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such*
35 *invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which*

1 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
2 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

3

4 SECTION 13. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
5 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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7 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
8 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
9 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
10 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
11 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
14 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
