# A Bill

**ACT 96 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1283**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION  
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the War  
20 Memorial Stadium Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum  
21 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions  
22 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201  
23 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,  
24 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set  
25 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
26 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
29 successor.

9 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the War  
10 Memorial Stadium Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum  
11 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
12 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: One hundred twenty  
13 five (125) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not  
14 to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act,  
15 or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

16  
17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War  
18 Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
19 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the War Memorial Stadium Commission, for personal  
20 services and operating expenses of the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the  
21 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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5 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War  
6 Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from the War Memorial Stadium  
7 Improvement and Expansion Fund, to be used to supplement monies raised by the  
8 issuance of revenue bonds for stadium improvement and expansion purposes, if  
9 authorized by law, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the  
10 following:

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16 SECTION 5. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in  
17 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment  
18 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in  
19 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the  
20 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the  
21 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine  
22 that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal  
23 services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may  
24 authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated  
25 for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

- 26 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that  
27 such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and  
28 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the  
29 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

30 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of  
31 the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with  
32 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such  
33 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and  
34 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

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1           SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
2 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
3 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
4 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
7 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
8 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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11           SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
13 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
14 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20           SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
21 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
22 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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24           SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
25 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
26 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
27 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
28 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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30           SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
31 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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33           SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
34 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
35 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that

1 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
2 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
3 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
4 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
5 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
6 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
7 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
8 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
