19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated § 6-20-1201 is hereby amended to
22	read as follows:
23	"6-20-1201. Authority to borrow money and issue negotiable bonds.
24	All school districts are authorized to borrow money and issue negotiable
25	bonds for the repayment thereof from school funds for the building and
26	equipment of school buildings, making additions and repairs thereto,
27	purchasing sites therefor, purchasing new or used school buses, refurbishing
28	school buses, and paying off outstanding postdated warrants, installment
29	contracts, revolving loans and lease purchase agreements, as provided in this
30	act."
31	
32	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
33	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
35	
36	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 7 hereby repealed.

9 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the 10 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly that present limitations on the use of 11 negotiable bonds issued by school districts are creating serious hardships for 12 some Arkansas districts; that it is essential to the financial stability of 13 these school districts that they be authorized to issue bonds to pay off and 14 extend certain kinds of short term debt and that the authority conferred 15 hereby should be available as soon as possible. Therefore, an emergency is 16 declared to exist and this Act being essential for the preservation of the 17 public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be in force from and 18 after its passage and approval.
