ACT 1017 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 17

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS MINORITY HEALTH
10 COMMISSION FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997;
11 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS MINORITY HEALTH
15 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 1995-97
16 BIENNIUM."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 Arkansas Minority Health Commission for the 1995-97 biennium, the following
22 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
23 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
24 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
25 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
26 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
30 successor.

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4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
5 Arkansas Minority Health Commission, to be payable from the *State General*
6 *Services* Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas
7 Minority Health Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1997, the
8 following:

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23 SECTION 3. *The Commission may, by a majority vote of the total membership*
24 *of the Commission, cast at its first regularly scheduled meeting of each*
25 *calendar year, authorize expense reimbursement for Commission members*
26 *performing official duties of the Commission and such expense reimbursement*
27 *shall not exceed the rate established for state employees in the state travel*
28 *regulations.*

30 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
31 by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
33 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
34 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
35 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of

1 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
2 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
3 with in disbursement of said funds.

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5 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
6 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
7 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
8 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
9 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
11 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
12 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
15 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
16 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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18 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
19 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
20 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
21 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
22 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

24 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
25 this Act are hereby repealed.

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27 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
28 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
29 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
30 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
