20	SECTION 1. SECTION 4 of Uncodified Act 517 of 1995 is amended to read								
21	as follows:								
22	"SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §§27-101-202(1) and (2) are amended to read								
23	as follows:								
24	_(1) Shall operate any motorboat or vessel or manipulate any water								
25	skis, aquaplane, personal watercraft, or similar device in a reckless or								
26	negligent manner that endangers the life, limb, or property of any person;								
27	including but not limited to weaving through congested vessel traffic,								
28	operating within one hundred (100) feet of a towboat that is underway, jumping								
29	the wake of another vessel too close to such other vessel, or when visibility								
30	around such other vessel is obstructed and swerving at the last possible								
31	moment to avoid collision shall constitute reckless operation of a vessel;								
32	(2) Shall operate a motorboat on the waters of this state at a rate of								
33	speed that creates a hazardous wash or wake upon approaching or passing								
34	vessels; including, but not limited to a wake that causes other vessels to								
35	take-on water, or a wake sufficient to toss occupants of other vessels about								
36	in a manner to cause injury or the risk of injury;'"

3 SECTION 2. (a) The Eightieth General Assembly of the State of Arkansas 4 finds that the portion of Eleven Point River located in Randolph County, from 5 its confluence with the Spring River at the Randolph and Lawrence County line, 6 north, upstream to the Missouri state line, possesses unique and outstanding 7 scenic, recreational, botanical, faunal, and other outdoor values of vital 8 interest and present and potential benefit to the people of the State of 9 Arkansas, and the preservation of its unpolluted and natural state is 10 essential for this and future generations.

(b) In furtherance of the purposes set forth in subsection (a) of this section, from and after the effective date of this act, it shall be unlawful for any motorboat equipped with a greater than twenty-five (25) horsepower engine to operate or navigate on the Eleven Point River from its confluence with the Spring River at the Randolph and Lawrence County line, north, upstream to the Missouri state line. As used in this act, the term "motorboat" shall have the same meaning as the term is defined in Arkansas Code § 27-101-103.

(c) Nothing in this section shall affect the jurisdictions or responsibilities of state agencies or political subdivisions of the State of Arkansas in the enforcement of laws with respect to water, fish, and wildlife and other related resources. This section is intended to supplementary and in addition to all other Arkansas law regulating the use of waterways, motorboats, and natural scenic rivers.

26 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 27 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 28 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

30 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 31 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 32 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 33 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 34 act are declared to be severable.
