Nothing in this act shall be construed as Limiting or superseding any legislative act prohibiting mining in 7 streams designated as extraordinary resource waters, or detracting from the 8 General Assembly's conclusion that all Arkansas streams must be protected from 9 indiscriminate mining; (2) Affecting the authority of the Arkansas Pollution Control & Ecology 10 11 Commission to promulgate regulations implementing any other act of the General 12 Assembly; or (3) Limiting the authority of the Arkansas Department of Pollution 13 14 Control & Ecology to enforce any duly enacted laws or regulations limiting or 15 prohibiting stream bed mining. 16 SECTION 4.
