20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22	SECTION 1. Subchapter 1 of Chapter 2 of title 11 of the Arkansas Code
23	is amended by inserting an additional section at the end thereof to read as
24	follows:
25	"11-2-122. Disclosure to Employees - health benefits available.
26	Any employer or owner who does make available to his employees any
27	health benefits, excluding workers_ compensation, shall inform and notify his
28	employees of the nature of those benefits as to those benefits being self-
29	insured, fully-insured, or ERISA-qualified, and shall provide the necessary
3 0	information to enable his employees to contact the authority regulating those
31	health benefits. The notification shall be made at such time and in such
32	manner as prescribed by regulation promulgated by the Director of Labor."
33	
34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 6 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
