18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 13-8-102 is amended to read as follows:
21	"13-8-102. Definitions.
22	As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
23	(1) _The office_ means the Office of Arkansas State Arts and Humanities
	established in this subchapter. The office shall include the advisory council
25	and the position of executive director as established in this subchapter;
26	(2) _The arts_ includes, but is not limited to, instrumental and vocal

28	allied fields, graphic, folk art, porcelain art, china painting, craft art,

31	performance, execution, and exhibition of such major art forms;
32	(3) _Production_ means plays, with or without music, ballet, dance and
33	choral performances, concerts, recitals, opera, exhibitions, readings, motion

	activities involving the execution or rendition of the arts, and meeting any

(4) Project means programs organized to carry out the purposes of 2 this subchapter including programs to foster artistic creativity, to 3 commission works of art, to create opportunities for individuals to develop 4 artistic talents when carried on as a part of a program otherwise included in 5 this definition, and to develop and enhance public knowledge and understanding 6 of the arts and humanities. The term \_project\_ also includes, where 7 appropriate, rental, purchases, renovation, or construction of facilities, 8 purchase or rental of land, and acquisition of equipment, supplies, materials, 9 and other personal property; (5) Group includes any state or other public agency, and any 11 nonprofit society, institution, organization, association, museum, or 12 establishment in Arkansas, whether or not incorporated; (6) Humanities includes, but is not limited to, the study of the 13 14 following: language, both modern and classic; linguistics; literature; 15 history; jurisprudence; philosophy; archeology; the history, criticism, 16 theory, and practice of the arts; and those aspects of the social sciences 17 which have humanistic content and employ humanistic methods." 18 19 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature 20 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 21 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 22 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to 23 24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect 25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 26 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this 27 act are declared to be severable. 28 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 29 30 hereby repealed. 31 32 33 APPROVED: 4-10-95 34 35
