17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-311(c) is amended to read as follows:
20	"(c) All rules, regulations, and procedures authorized by the State
21	Board of Election Commissioners to enable disabled persons to vote shall be
22	designed to permit the voter to personally and secretly execute his ballot
23	without the assistance of a third party unless third-party assistance is
24	requested by the disabled voter. When any qualified elector notifies an
25	election official at the voting precinct that he or she is unable to read the
26	ballot, the election official shall cause the entire ballot to be read to the
27	voter, unless the voter instructs otherwise. The election official shall then
28	assist the voter without comment or interpretation in marking the ballot. If
29	the voter designates a person to assist, the election official shall allow
30	that person to assist the voter and the person designated shall read the
31	entire ballot to the voter, unless the voter instructs otherwise, and then
32	assist the voter without comment or interpretation in marking the ballot."

34	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
35	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 3 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 4 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 5 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 6 act are declared to be severable.
