Arkansas Code 10-3-301(d) is amended to read as follows: 19 20 "(d) Following the selection by caucus of the regular and alternate 21 members of the Council from the respective congressional districts and House 22 caucus districts, the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint 23 from the membership of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate 24 shall appoint from the membership of the Senate their first and second 25 alternate members. These members shall not be members or alternate members of 26 the Council selected by House caucus district caucus or congressional district 27 caucus or by the entire membership of the House or Senate. The designation of 28 first and second alternate members for the Speaker of the House and President 29 Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be made prior to adjournment of each regular 30 session of the General Assembly. The names of the persons shall be entered 31 upon the journal of the respective houses." 32 33 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 34 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 35 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
