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20	SECTION 1. Legislative Findings and Declaration of Public Necessity:

25	(b) It is the purpose of this act to establish a <i>utilization review</i> and
	treatment program to reduce violence among persons who suffer from mental
	illness and who abuse chemical substances without a costly expansion of the

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30	SECTION 2. Definition:
31	For purposes of this act, _client_ means a person diagnosed to be
	addicted to drugs or alcohol who has been committed to the custody of the
	Director of the Department of Human Services pursuant to Ark. Code 5-2-314 as
	a result of acquittal, on the ground of mental disease or defect, of an
	offense involving bodily injury to another person, or serious risk of such
36	injury.

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         SECTION 3. The Arkansas Department of Human Services shall establish a
 3 system to:

         (b) provide case management of clients;
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         (c) provide one or more secure residential treatment facility or
 7 facilities designed to treat clients;
         (d) provide community crisis stabilization beds for clients; and

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         SECTION 4. The Arkansas Department of Human Services is authorized to
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13 enter into contracts with any public or private non-profit entity for the
14 purpose of implementing this act.
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         SECTION 5. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
17 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
18 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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         SECTION 6. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
24 act are declared to be severable.
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         SECTION 7. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
