8	"AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 27 OF THE ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED
9	TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL CHAPTER 90 THERETO FOR THE PURPOSES
10	OF AUTHORIZING THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO
11	ESTABLISH TURNPIKE PROJECTS AND TO COLLECT TOLLS; AND FOR
12	OTHER PURPOSES."

15	"TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY
16	COMMISSION TO ESTABLISH TURNPIKE
17	PROJECTS AND TO COLLECT TOLLS."

19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20	
21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated Title 27 is amended to add an
22	additional Chapter 90 thereto to read as follows:
23	"CHAPTER 90. TOLL HIGHWAYS
24	27-90-101. As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
25	requires:
26	(1) 'Commission' means the State Highway Commission;
27	(2) 'Project' or 'turnpike project' means any highway on or a part of
28	the state highway system constructed, reconstructed, or rehabilitated under
29	the provisions of this chapter by the commission, including, without
30	limitation, lands, rights-of-way, bridges, tunnels, overpasses, underpasses,
31	interchanges, entrance plazas, approaches, toll houses, administration
32	buildings, storage buildings, other buildings, and facilities which the
33	commission may deem necessary or desirable for the operation of a turnpike
34	project, together with all property, rights, easements, rights-of-way, and
35	interest that may be acquired by the commission for or in connection with the
36	construction or operation of a turnpike project. Each turnpike project shall

- 1 be separately designated by appropriate name or number and may be constructed,
- 2 reconstructed, rehabilitated, or extended in sections and stages as the
- 3 commission may from time to time determine.
- 4 27-90-102. (a) In addition to all other authorities of the commission,
- 5 the commission shall have the authority to undertake turnpike projects.
- 6 (b) No turnpike project shall be undertaken:
- 7 (1) Unless and until the turnpike project involved shall have
- 8 been thoroughly studied with respect to traffic, engineering, costs, and
- 9 financing; and
- 10 (2) Unless the commission makes, by resolution duly entered in
- 11 the records of the commission, a determination based upon study that public
- 12 funds, or funds available from any other source, for construction,
- 13 reconstruction, or rehabilitation of a free, without toll, highway are not
- 14 sufficient.
- 15 27-90-103. (a) The commission is authorized to fix, revise, charge, and
- 16 collect tolls for the use of each turnpike project and the different parts or
- 17 sections thereof and to contract with any person, partnership, association,
- 18 corporation, or organization desiring the use of any part thereof, and to fix
- 19 the terms, conditions, rents, and rates of charges for use. However, public
- 20 utilities of the State, rural electric and telephone cooperatives, political
- 21 subdivisions, and pipeline companies may construct and maintain crossings of
- 22 turnpike projects with their facilities, without charge, if the facilities are
- 23 constructed and maintained in compliance with reasonable requirements of
- 24 public safety and all costs of restoring the project to as good a condition as
- 25 it was before being disturbed are paid by the owner of the facilities.
- 26 (b) The tolls authorized by this chapter shall not be subject to
- 27 supervision or regulation by any other commission, board, bureau, or agency of
- 28 the State of Arkansas.
- 29 27-90-104. (a) All revenue derived from this chapter shall be
- 30 classified as special revenues and shall be deposited in the State Treasury.
- 31 (b) The net amount thereof shall be transferred by the Treasurer of
- 32 State on the last business day of each month to the Arkansas State Highway and
- 33 Transportation Department, there to be used for the maintenance, operation,
- 34 and improvement required by the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
- 35 Department in carrying out its functions, powers, and duties."

2	SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
3	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
4	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
5	
6	SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to
7	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
8	other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without
9	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10	Act are declared to be severable.
11	
12	SECTION 4. Ark. Code Ann. §§27-71-501 through 27-71-504 are hereby
13	specifically repealed. All other laws and parts of laws in conflict with this
14	act are hereby repealed.
