- 2 (4) "Department" means the Arkansas Department of Education, General
- 3 Education Division.
- 4 (5) "Director" means the Director of the General Education Division of

- 14 SECTION 4. (a) There is hereby established the Arkansas Distance
- 15 Learning Demonstration Project, which shall be conducted by OURNET and
- 16 administered through the Director of the General Education of the Arkansas
- 17 Department of Education.
- 18 (b)(1) The Director shall review the implementation of this project
- 19 annually and make recommendations to the Board regarding the number and amount
- 20 of awards to ensure that the purpose of the project is realized.
- 21 (2) The Board is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations
- 22 necessary for the implementation of this act.

- 24 SECTION 5. The funding necessary to carry out the provisions of this
- 25 act may be derived from donations, grants, or legislative appropriation. The
- 26 Director may solicit and receive donations and grants for the purpose of
- 27 administering the project. All donations, grants, and appropriations received
- 28 shall be accounted for by the Department.

- 30 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
- 31 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
- 32 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

- 34 SECTION 7. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
- 35 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 3 act are declared to be severable.
         SECTION 8. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
 6 hereby repealed.

         SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the General
9 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the effectiveness of this act on
10 July 1,. 1995, is essential to the successful establishment of a distance
11 learning demonstration project in Arkansas high schools during the 1995-96
12 school year and to the planning and efficiency of the state agencies and local
13 school districts involved in the project. Therefore, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation
15 of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full force and effect
16 from and after July 1, 1995.
